Think about this...

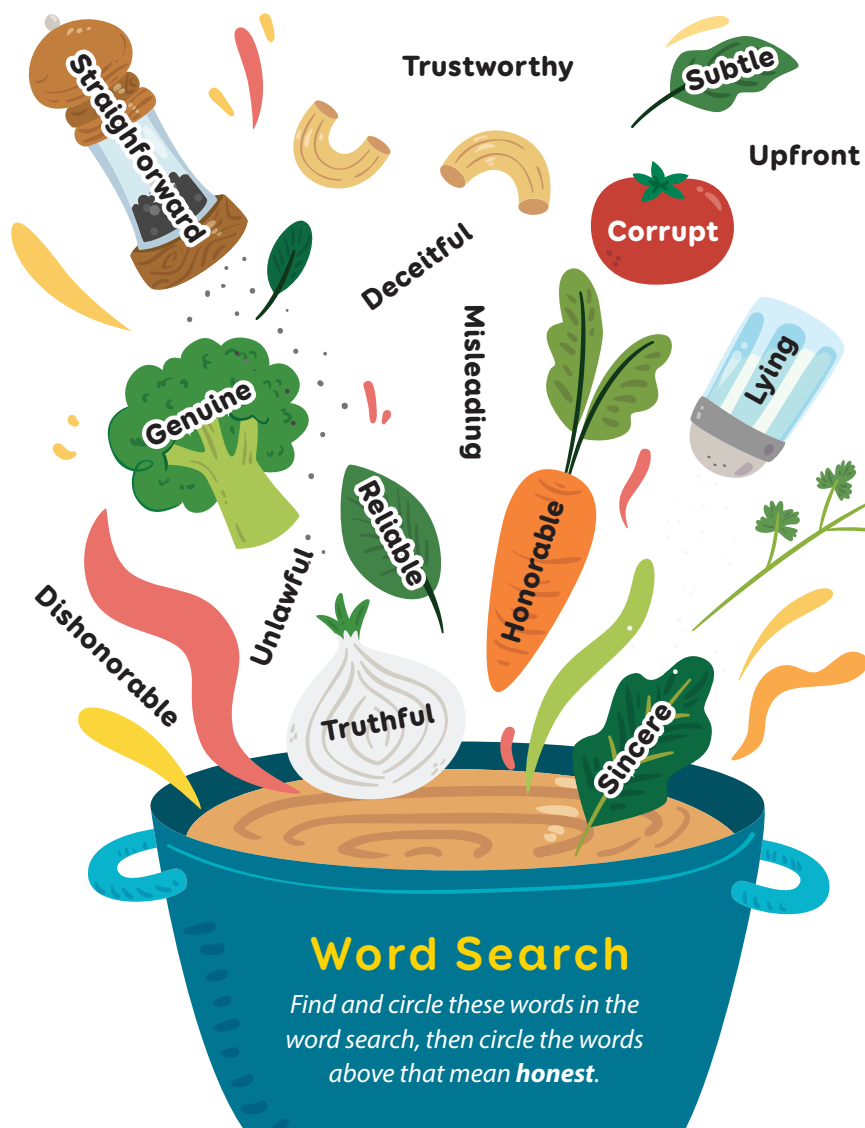
