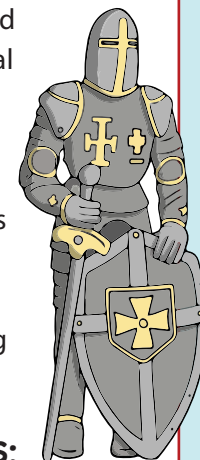

Although it provided protection, medieval armor weighed between 35 and 55 pounds. Apart from its protection, it was difficult to move in and prevented a soldier from moving very fast.



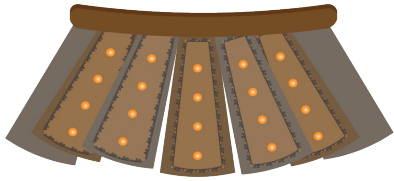
